

How do I pin the screen on a Honeywell EDA50 EDA51?

There are times when we need someone else to use our Honeywell EDA51 to view a photo or video, use an app, or visit a webpage, but we don't want them to have access to the other apps and data on our device, whether for privacy, security, or to prevent accidents.

For example, there are times when we need to give the Honeywell EDA51 to a friend, family member, or even a young child, and we don't want them to leave the app we have open. This is very useful, for instance, so that young children can watch YouTube videos without leaving the app, and we can even prevent them from doing anything other than watching—that is, by **locking** the touchscreen until we want them to.

Imagine you want to let someone see a photo or video on Instagram, but you don't want them to be able to "like" that post or see the rest of your posts and "gossip." It's possible to do this on our Honeywell EDA51. Follow the steps below, and we'll tell you how to configure it.

This feature is only available from Android version 9 onwards; the Honeywell EDA51 comes from the factory with Android version 8.0.

Estimated time: 2 minutes.

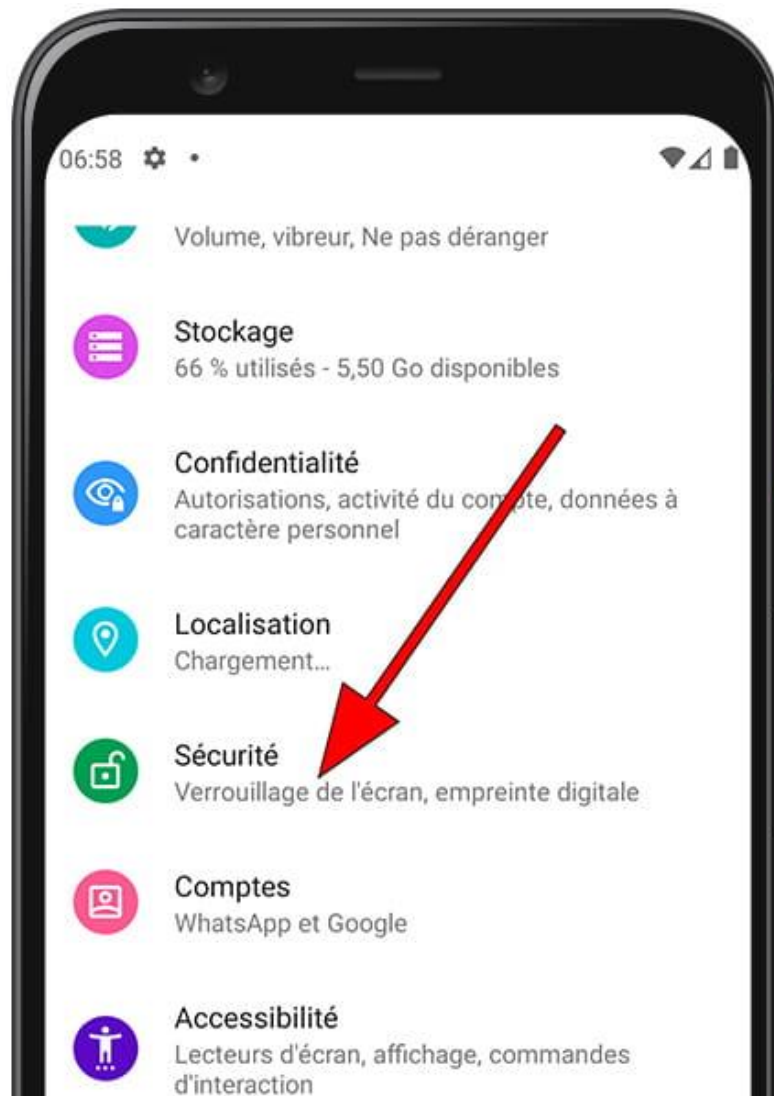
1- First step:

Since most Android "Screen Pinning" functions need to be enabled from the Honeywell EDA51 settings, we click on "Settings" to begin the configuration.



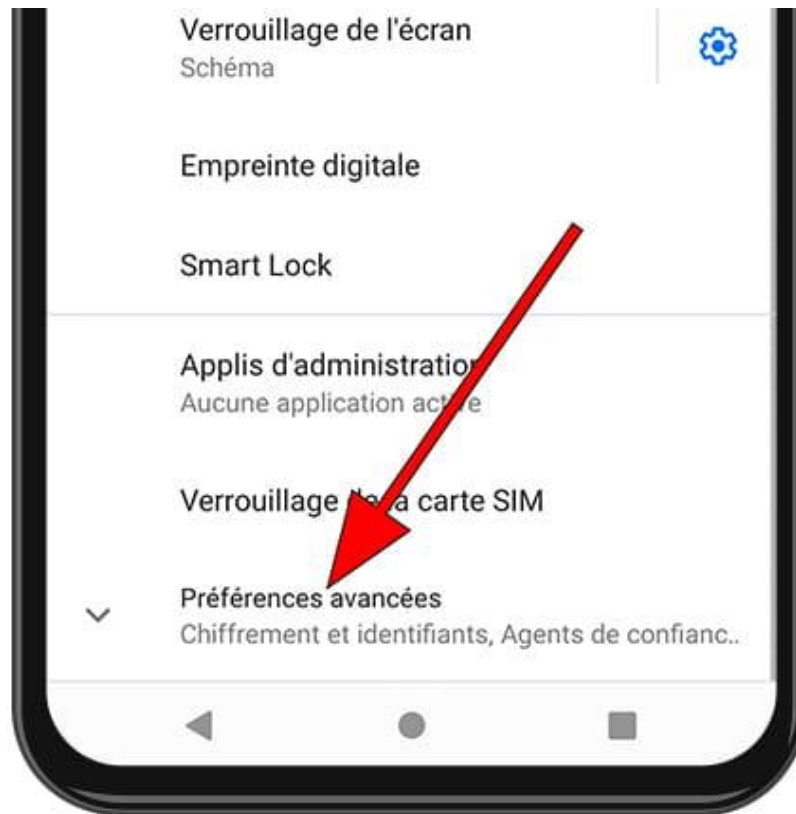
2- Second step:

Scroll through the settings of the Honeywell EDA51, find the section titled "Security", click to access.



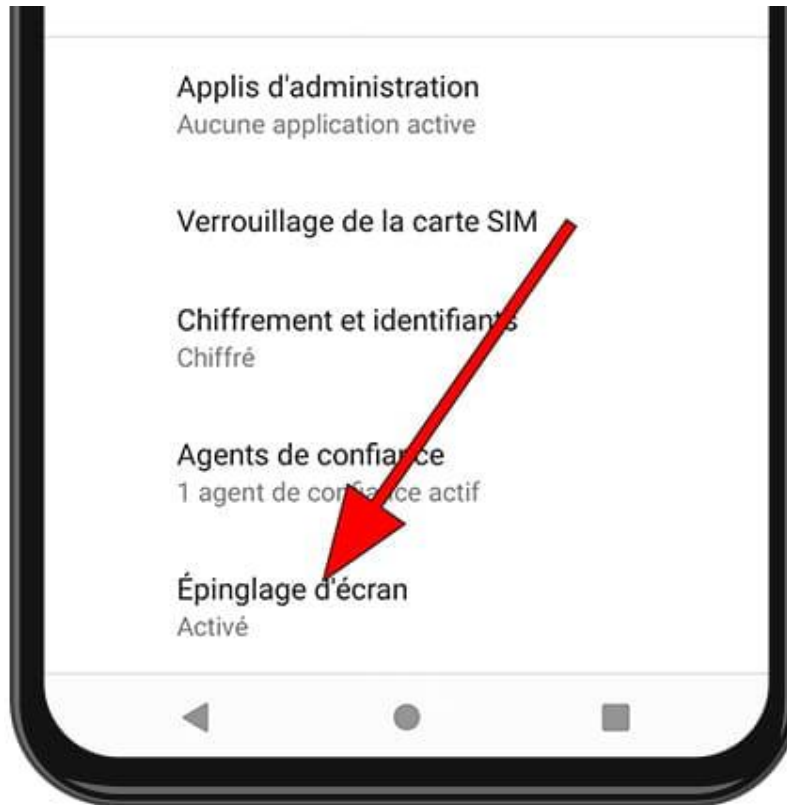
3- Third step:

screen pinning function is somewhat hidden in the settings of the Honeywell EDA51, so you need to click on "Advanced" to access these hidden settings.



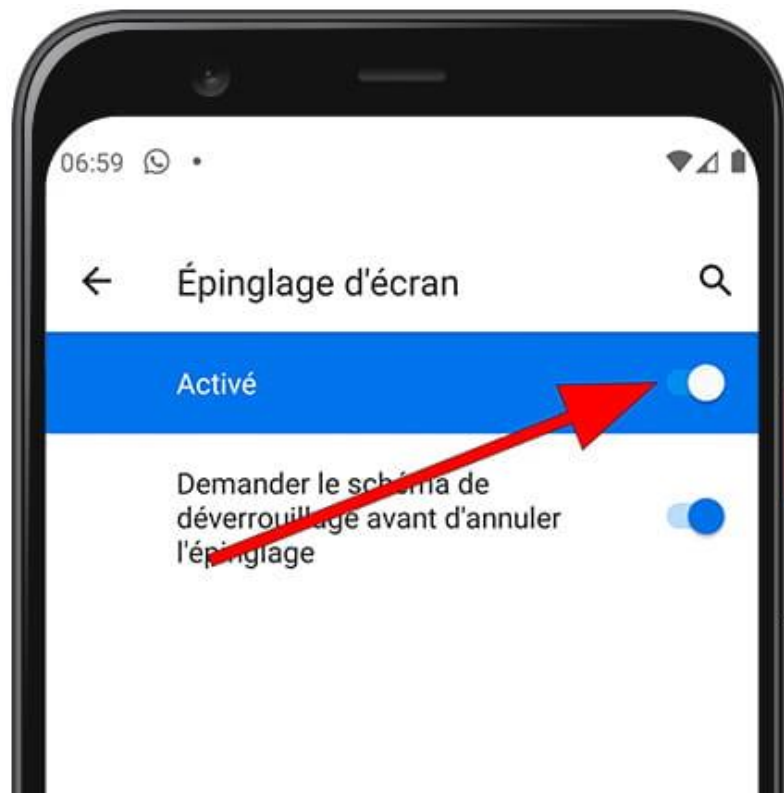
4- Fourth step:

Scroll down the Honeywell EDA51 screen until you find the "Screen Pinning" section, tap to activate it and set its parameters.



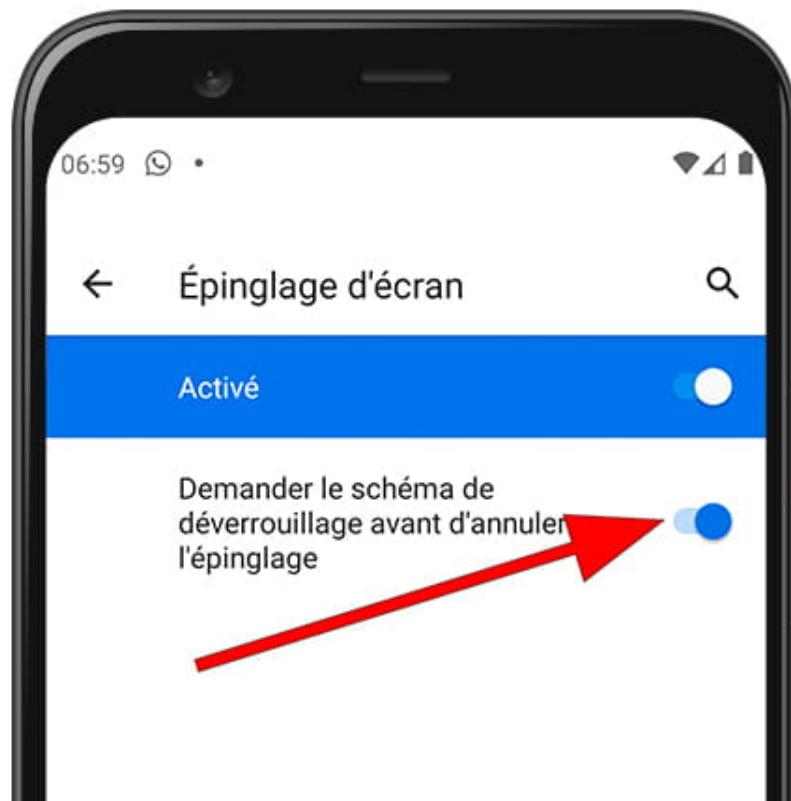
5- Fifth step:

Tap to enable "Screen Pinning" if it is not active.



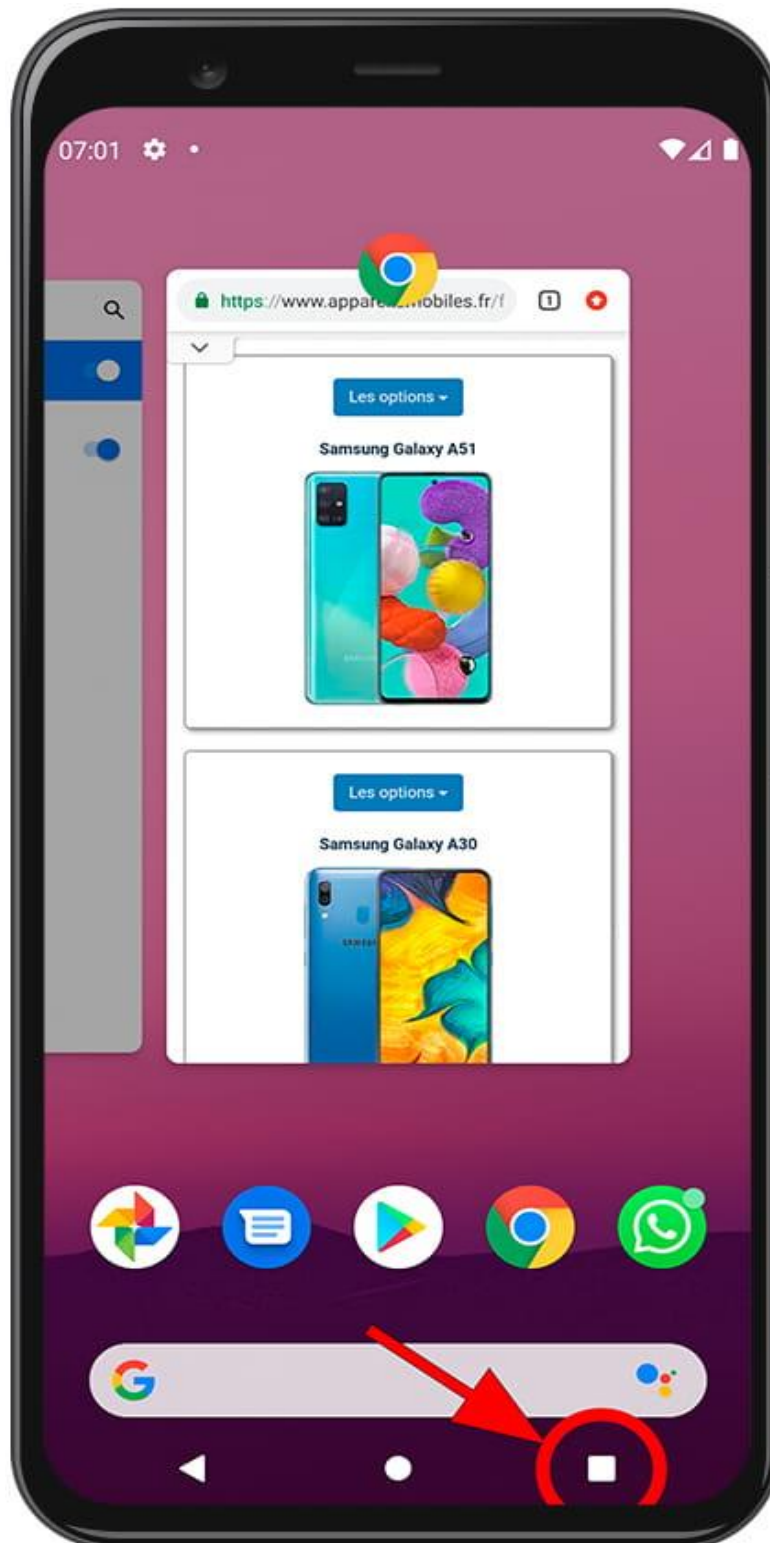
6- Sixth step:

Click on "Request unlock pattern before cancel pinning" if you want to enter a different code than the one you have to unlock the Honeywell EDA51, this way you can protect your personal unlock code or pattern.



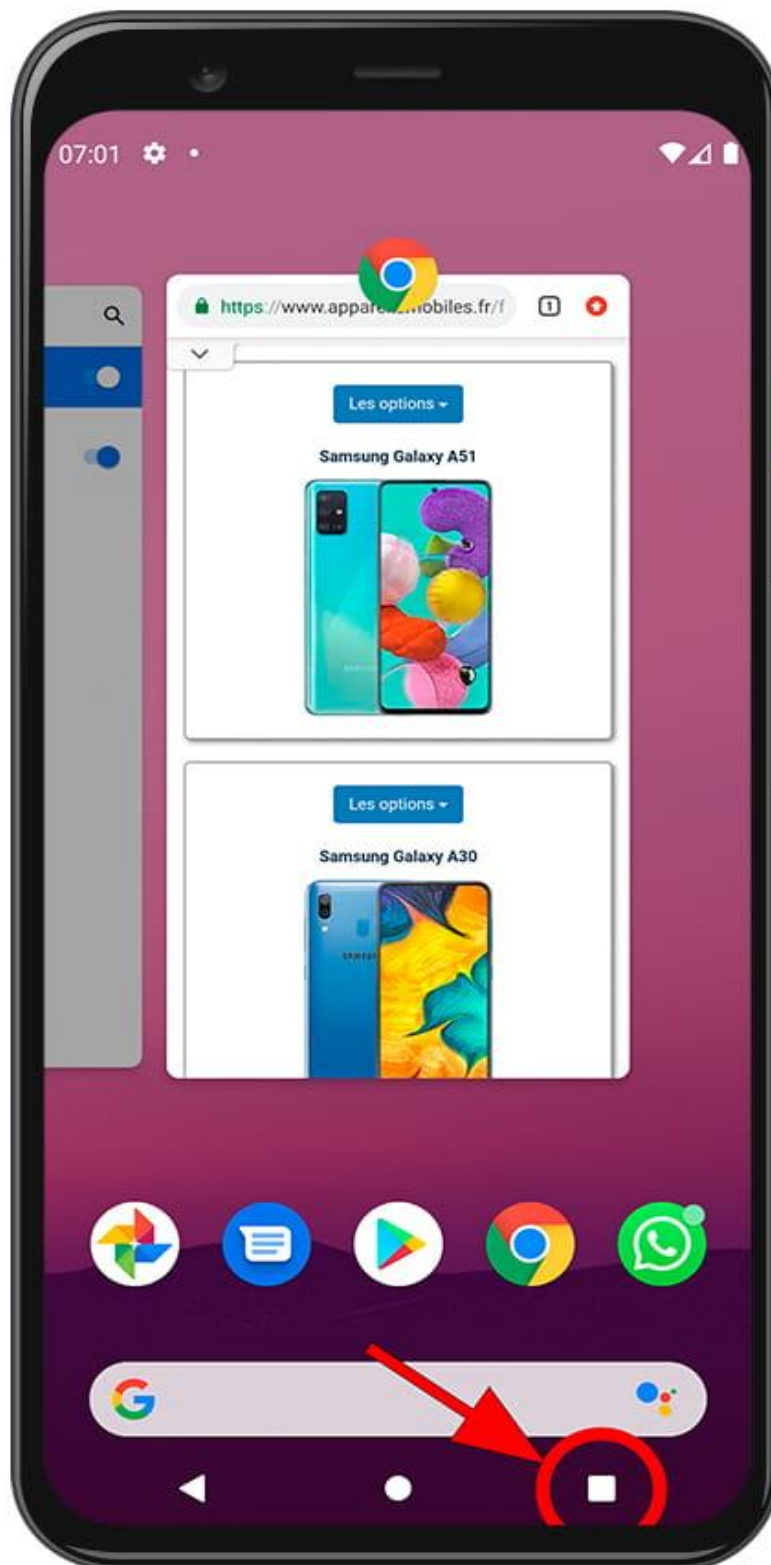
7- Seventh step:

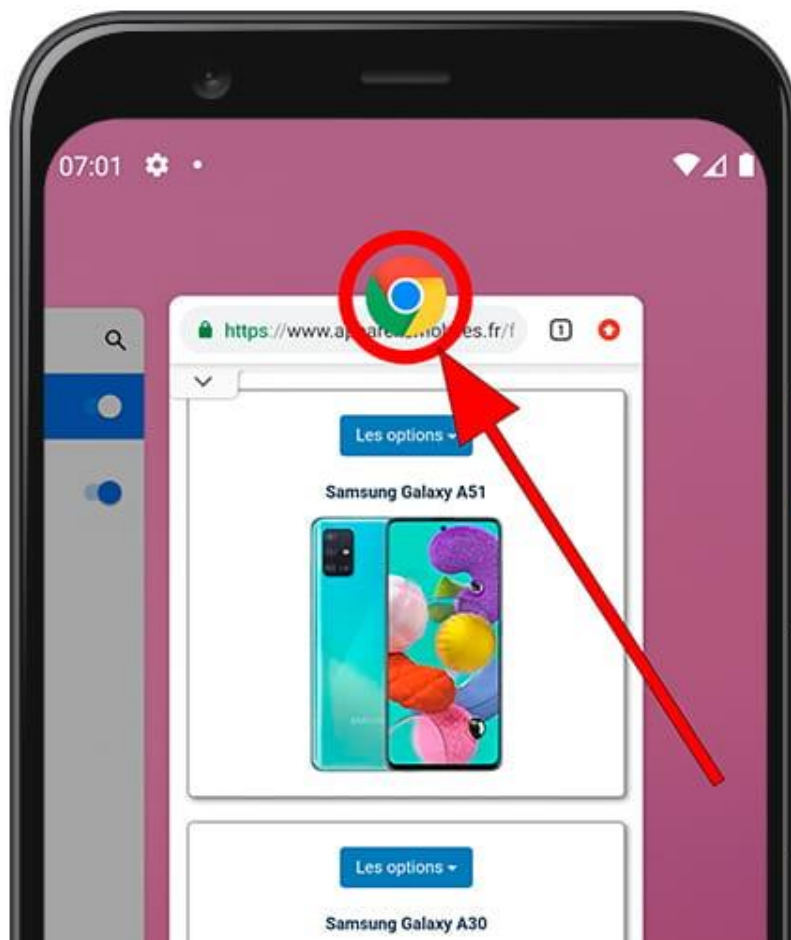
We've already activated this very useful feature for lending the Honeywell EDA51 to someone else. Now, to test or use it, you need to open the application you want to "pin" or keep open so you can't exit it without unlocking the EDA51. Once open, you need to click the recent apps button, which is the square button in the bottom right corner of your EDA51's screen.



8- Eighth step:

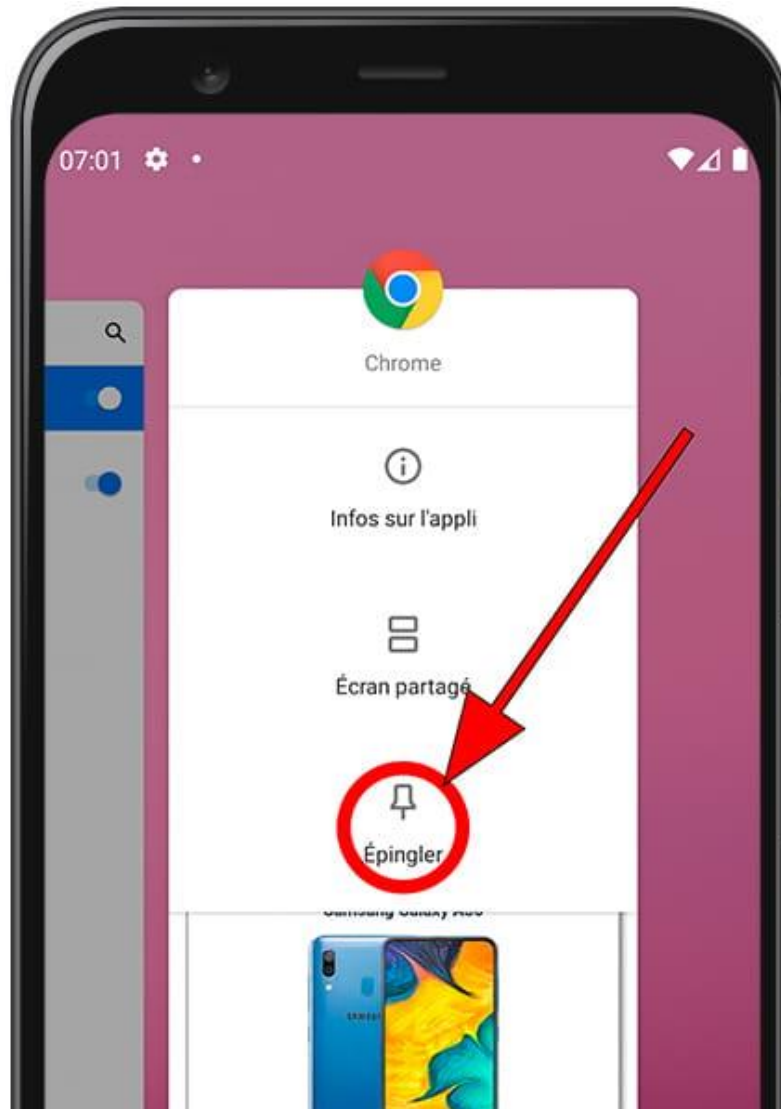
Now click on the app icon you want to "Screen Pin" to display the menu of available options.





9- Ninth stage:

Among the options that will now appear, you will see "Pin" next to a pin icon. Tap to pin this app to your Honeywell EDA51.



10- Tenth step

You already have the application locked to the screen; anyone using your Honeywell EDA51 will not be able to exit the application without knowing the unlock code or pattern you set. When you are finished and wish to disable or stop the setup of this application, you must press and hold the back and recent apps buttons simultaneously, as shown in the image below.

With these simple steps, we have learned how to activate and use "Screen Pinning" in our Honeywell EDA51; once configured, you can use it at any time by pressing the recent applications button as shown in point seven.



The latest versions of Google only require pressing the back button to unpin.
